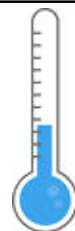

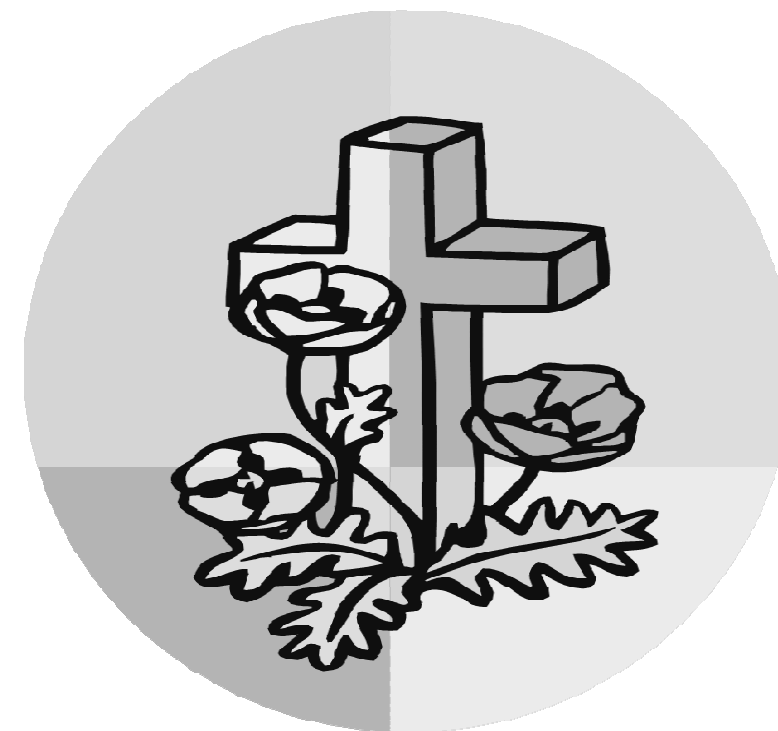

In 2017, there were 68.5 million children, women, and men uprooted from their homes. The majority of them are currently in some of the poorest countries on the planet.

"What I miss the most about Syria is my house, my homeland, my mother, and my father. I haven't seen them in five years. Before I felt secure, in my house, in my country. Now, my life is temporary; my tent could burn down. Two years ago, the tent we were in went up in flames."
