Introduction to the Enneagram

Anthony De Mello S.J. once said that most people sleep through their lives. If that is true, how do we awaken? The Enneagram is one tool that offers a glimpse into our sacred self. This glimpse invites us to examine our individual way of being, our woundedness and our path to healing. The workshop will give a brief overview of where the Enneagram came from. The nine types, the needs of each type, addictive tendencies and the path to healing.
