Catholic Missions in Canada

Catholic Missions in Canada funds the work of missionaries as they proclaim the Word of God across the nation, even in the most remote and in-need areas. Your contribution on *World Mission Sunday* allows us to serve mission territories around the world. The Diocese of London is specifically partnered through the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB) to support the Diocese of Whitehorse, Yukon (YT). The Diocese of Whitehorse is comprised of twenty-three parishes and missions spread over a 723,515 sq. km area in Yukon and northern British Columbia, with an estimated Catholic population of seventy-five hundred people. The area is vast; the workers are few, as in the beginning (cf. *Mt* 9:37). Visitors to this area are inspired by the stillness of the land, the hospitality of the people, and the touch of the Spirit.

Record of the first Catholic missionary to arrive in the territory dates from September, 1861! In 1942, the building of the Alaska Highway, which runs for 1,600 km through the diocese, brought with it a complete new way of life as well as opening up the territory both materially and spiritually. The Diocese achieved diocesan status in July of 1967. The Office of the Bishop, the Chancery Office and the Cathedral are located in Whitehorse. In February 2016, Bishop Hector Villa became the sixth Bishop of the Diocese.

The Roman Catholic Diocese of Whitehorse has a two-fold mission: to compassionately assist all people in need and to boldly proclaim the Good News of God's saving grace to the ends of the world.

The Diocese of London has been reaching out to Whitehorse for the last few years to support their mission statement.
