#### Organizers are planning another June 27th Miracle

The donation drive was such a big success last year that it collected more than 2-million pounds of food. Over 28,000 families and 120 organizations benefitted.

"Hunger is something that is very primal and something we believe is a human right," said committee member Matt Hernandez. "We know there's a lot of children, families that have been impacted greatly because of this pandemic and other factors."

He said organizers learned a lot from last year's effort, so there will be one major change for organizations that need food.

"We are asking organizations in the community that want to receive the food to register via our website," "That way, we can work with them to ensure that this goes directly to the people who need it."

#### The donation drive also needs volunteers.

Last year, 10,000 volunteers came out to help.

## **In-person Masses can Resume in the Diocese of London Effective June 11, 2021**

**June 8, 2021**

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,**

**We are all pleased to hear the good news from the provincial Government that the implementation of its "Roadmap to Reopen" framework is beginning earlier than initially communicated. Step 1 of the framework will begin on Friday, 11 June at 12:01 a.m. This change now includes allowing indoor religious rites to resume at 15% capacity and outdoor with no limit as long as physical distancing can be assured. Communication regarding how the changes affect parish halls and offices will be forthcoming.**

**In consultation with the Episcopal Conference, I have decided that our churches may reopen as soon as they are able to after the Province moves into Step 1 on Friday, 11 June. Those parishes and communities that will not be ready to reopen this weekend may delay opening as required, but no later than the following weekend, 19/20 June. Any parish that cannot meet that date should contact my office.**

**All churches that open will be subject to the laws of the Province and the safety directives that I have issued since June 2020. We must be vigilant in following these laws and directives.**

**We are grateful that the government has recognized the importance of our churches and how hard we have worked to ensure that attending Mass remains safe.**

**We thank God for this blessing and will continue to pray for the souls of the deceased and the comfort of their families, for a full recovery of those who are sick and for those who care for them.**

### **Summary of Minutes of Transition Team meeting June 3, 2021**

The Transition Team of the Lakes Erie and St. Clair Catholic Family of Parishes continues to prepare our parishes for the July activation of our Family.

We are nearly finished setting a Mass schedule and will share it with you as soon as we have the final go-ahead from the Diocese. We are trying to ensure that every parish has at least one Sunday Mass, that there will still be some Saturday evening masses and that French language masses continue in the two francophone parishes. The final schedule will be posted very soon!

Keep in mind that the schedule will be on a trial basis for the first six months, at which time it will be re-evaluated to see if it should continue as planned.

The Team has also proposed an office schedule for the secretarial/financial staff. The Visitation parish office to be open full time, Monday to Friday. The satellite offices (St. Francis and Immaculée Conception) to be open part-time. We are ensuring that each staff member has the same number of hours. Exact days and hours are to be posted as soon as possible.

We are finalizing plans for the digital communication for our Family. There will be one website, one bulletin, one Facebook page and one YouTube channel for all of our communication within the parishes. The website will include a French version, complete with the same information found on the English version. We are also working on a Logo for our Family, which you will see frequently in our communications with you.

July 1 is rapidly approaching and you can be assured that the Team members are keeping all of the needs of the parishioners in mind for every decision we make. We are trying to keep the impact of changes to a minimum, but realize that some change is necessary while we transition to the new Family.

### **Résumé du procès-verbal de la réunion de l'Équipe de transition du 3 juin 2021**

L'équipe de transition de La famille des paroisses catholiques des Lacs Érié et Ste-Claire continue à préparer nos paroisses pour l'activation de notre famille en juillet.

Nous avons presque fini d'établir un horaire des messes et nous le partagerons avec vous dès que nous aurons reçu la confirmation finale du Diocèse. Nous essayons de faire en sorte que chaque paroisse ait au moins une messe dominicale, qu'il y ait encore des messes le samedi soir et que les messes en français continuent dans les deux paroisses francophones. L'horaire définitif sera affiché sous peu !

Les jours et heures exactes seront affichés dès que possible.

Nous sommes en train de finaliser les plans pour la communication digitale de notre Famille. Il y aura un site web, un bulletin, une page Facebook et un poste YouTube pour toute notre communication au sein des paroisses. Le site web comprendra une version française, avec les mêmes informations que la version anglaise. Nous travaillons également sur un logo pour notre Famille, que vous verrez fréquemment lors de nos communications avec vous.

Le 1er juillet approche à grands pas et vous pouvez être assurés que les membres de l'équipe gardent à l'esprit tous les besoins des paroissiens et paroissiennes pour chaque décision que nous prenons. Nous essayons de limiter au maximum l'impact des changements, mais nous sommes conscients que certains changements sont nécessaires lors de la transition vers la nouvelle Famille.
